A. 21-23 WEST FERRY STREET FORMAL

Many renovations and improvements to the property.

HISTORIC BACKGROUND

This building is known as the Beaumont House, built in 1785 and is considered a SIGNIFICANT contribution to the Historic inventory for all the nationally registered properties in New Hope.

B. THE LANDING /22 NORTH MAIN STREET LAST CONCEPT REVIEW

FRED'S BREAKFAST BUILDING/13 RANDOLPH STREET

Demolition of the interior of the house at the Landing and converted into a Residential unit.

The restaurant and outdoor bar will remain.

Demolition of Fred's Breakfast building and converted into a 44 Room Boutique.

HISTORIC BACKGROUND

Two separate parcels

22 North Main Street is known as the Hiram Scarborough House, built in 1865.

Randolph Street (Fred's Breakfast SITE) is known as the Scarborough Fishery SITE dating back to the 1700's.

The Randolph Street SITE (which is what Fred's Breakfast building sits on), is considered SIGNIFICANT to the Historic inventory for all the nationally registered properties in New Hope.

The Landing House structure (which currently serves as the indoor dining), is also considered SIGNIFICANT to the Historic inventory for all the nationally registered properties in New Hope.

C. <u>KELLY McGowan /218 TOWPATH CONCEPT</u>

Demolition of a portion of the single family dwelling lacking historic significance and to maintain the historic part. They are planning to construct a 4-unit Townhouse up to three floors on the rest of the property.

HISTORIC BACKGROUND

This building was originally built in 1832 to house the lock tenders, and is known as Lockhouse #9. This building is considered a SIGNIFICANT contribution to the Historic inventory for all the nationally registered properties in New Hope.
