The following is a summary of the items on Council's agenda:

Presentation of Visitors Center Marketing Application

A presentation will be held during the meeting to discuss a marketing app for the Visitors Center.

Consider Amended Waiver of Land of Development–McDonalds, 324 West Bridge Street

This applicant has a request to remove the existing trash area add an exterior, outdoor double trash bay enclosure. There will also be an ADA compliant ramp and landscaping around the new trash enclosure.

Certificate of Appropriateness for 46 North Main Street – decorative fencing

The HARB application includes adding wrought iron fencing on the property. This will be presented to Council for consideration. This application was presented and approved by HARB at their meeting on February 9, 2021.

Certificate of Appropriateness for 82 South Main Street – re-siding, paint, light

The HARB application includes exterior painting, siding and a light fixture. This will be presented to Council for consideration. This application was presented and approved by HARB at their meeting on February 9, 2021.

ZHB Application – 49 West Mechanic Street – parking, driveway, impervious variances

This application will be presented to Council for consideration prior to being presented to the ZHB for review and approval for any variances requested.
