

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-05R

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW HOPE, COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2011-01R AND THE COMMUNITY ROOM FACILITY USE POLICY

WHEREAS, New Hope Borough Council established a community room facility use policy by Resolution No. 2011-01R, dated January 18, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to amend said facility use policy in order to ensure proper maintenance and care, and to prevent costly clean up and restoration expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by authority of the Council of the Borough of New Hope, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows.

Section 1. That Resolution No. 2011-01R and the *New Hope Borough Community Room Guidelines and Policies*, which were adopted by Council on January 18, 2011, are hereby amended to prohibit the rental or use of the community room by any individual, organization or group for functions, activities or gatherings that, in the judgment of the Borough, would likely result in 1) damages to the facility and/or grounds, 2) unfair maintenance and/or repair expenses borne by local taxpayers, 3) the cancellation of scheduled governmental meetings or community gatherings attributable to work undertaken to repair damaged facilities or grounds, and 4) excessive noise caused by music, dance or other sources that would disrupt Police Department operations and activities.

- A. Examples of functions, activities and gatherings that are not eligible for rental or use of the community room include, but are not limited to, weddings, bridal showers, anniversary parties, balls, dances, birthday parties, family reunions, and similar or like events.

Section 2. That all alcoholic beverages and catering services are prohibited at the New Hope Community Room.


Section 3. In addition, all inconsistent provisions of all other resolutions of the Borough of New Hope, Bucks County, Pennsylvania are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency. All other provisions of the resolutions of the Borough of New Hope, Bucks County, Pennsylvania shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Resolution is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Resolution.
